

## **MATURITY MODEL PILOT:**

In summary one can conclude that there are so many similarities in the structural arrangements of the FE and TVET as applied in Northern applied and South Africa respectively but there are also differences most of which emanate from the nature of autonomy prevailing at the Colleges in both Countries respectively.
